- Water restrictions have now been announced for Melbourne. Please be conscious that we are allowed to water only twice a week.
- Planting a water-wise garden is one of the most practical ways to save water and money.
- Mulching keeps weeds down and soil moist, and helps feed plants. But its most important job in our hot Florida climate is to keep the plant roots cool. So pile it on thick!
- Bougainvilleas are very tolerant of dry weather and a beautiful color show. These are great for planting in pots and require very little water, in fact, they will not flower with too much water. So, if your plants are covered in nice green leaves and no flowers, they are getting too much water.
- Have you got oil stains on your driveway I

We have a few homes that have STAINED their driveways and side walks. We know that this is a good idea to minimize stains in the concrete and improve the whole appearance. Financial status of the HOA funds:

Although we have a few homeowners who have not yet paid their annual fees (\$250), the fund is in good shape. We have budgeted \$53,000 as the operating and maintenance expense for 2009. This is less than \$1,500 more than 2008 and accounts for the various increases in costs. There have been some significant savings particularly the cost of insurance. We expect to have an extraordinary cost this year to divert and upgrade the storm drains in the NW corner of White Oak Circle. This will create a "short cut" from the drains to the pond to prevent the back-up and flooding that occurs during heavy rain. This cost, once contracted for and approved by the city will be paid for out of reserves.
